- 8. PRINCIPAL REPORT Larysa Hart
 - 8.1. Larysa shared some updates.
 - 8.1.1. The theme this year is building community and connection setting up opportunities for students, staff and community to connect.
 - 8.1.2. Rooms facing the compound have new window coverings to help with temperature control
 - 8.1.3. New learning spaces revamping of classrooms. Music room is now kindergarten room space is bigger, fresh air, room has a skylight, better lighting. More opportunities for play based learning.
 - 8.1.4. Kindergarten room is now learning hub teachers can bring students and do small group instructions. Sensory tools, decodable books and literacy



tools are available there. Teachers can gather in there and students can come together from different classrooms. A great place to build community.
