Ms. Baker	Performance Arts Kindergarten Room	Division 1 students have been learning about the basics of stop motion, including creating flip books, creating cut out animations and learning how to operate and create a film in the apps, iMovie and Stop Motion Studio. The students are proud to present a screening of their stop motion films.
Ms. Bagshaw	Leadership Room 5	The students are excited to share the ways they have demonstrated kindness and leadership within the school. Come meet the authors of the inspirational quotes posted on the school's message board. Hear about the ways they've been working with other students in the school by volunteering in classrooms.
