Teachers will view students as knowledge holders and utilize Indigenous

belonging, doing and knowing can be weaved in and design intentional
learning tasks.
- Using the seasonal planning tool incorporate land based learning, two-eyed
seeing, and literature that is written by Indigenous authors to design learning
tasks that support a culturally responsive learning environment.
- Creating opportunities for students, staff and families to build and nurture
learning relationships with Indigenous Elders and Knowledge Keepers that
fosters a spirit of reciprocity.
- Incorporating wraparound supports that address Spirit, Heart, Body, and
Mind as we work through Tiers of Support. Embedding these elements into
daily structures and processes to engage students more holistically while
intentionally integrating these aspects into classroom strategies.
