# How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
  - Instructional strategies
  - Professional learning
  - School structures and processes for learning
  - Resources to improve student learning
  - Data-informed decision making





# School Development Plan – School Goal

 Students' foundational skills in literacy and mathematics will improve.






# School Development Plan – Outcome

- Students will improve in reading through explicit, systematic instruction and frequent, actionable feedback.
- Students will improve mathematical procedural fluency through explicit, systematic instruction and frequent, actionable feedback.







# School Development Plan – Outcome Measures

- Report Card Data (Grade 1-6) Reading and Number
- Provincial Assessment: Gr. K-3 CC3, LeNS, Numeracy
- Grade 6 Provincial Achievement Test (Part A and Part B)







# School Development Plan – Data for Monitoring Progress

- Weekly (UFLI) student check-ins (reading/spelling)
- MathUP summative assessments
- Running Records (decodable/authentic text)
- Teacher perception data





# **School Development Plan – Actions**

- Learning Excellence Actions:
  - Explicit instruction using UFLI, decodable texts,
     MathUP, and Math Talks.
  - Build, share, and use exemplars with students to enrich student understanding of success criteria.
  - Utilize consistent, specific and timely formative assessment practices to move student learning forward.





# **School Development Plan – Actions**

- Well-Being Actions:
  - Provide feedback that moves learners forward.
  - Work alongside students to include them within formative feedback loops.
  - Model making mistakes and productive struggle as a path to mastery.
  - Explicit instruction to build motivation, engagement and executive function skills.





# School Development Plan – Actions

- Truth & Reconciliation, Diversity and Inclusion Actions:
  - Use scaffolded learning intentions (i.e., learners may have different learning goals).
  - Empower students to have voice in the learning and assessment process through intentional task design.
  - Utilize inclusive, linguistically and culturally diverse texts throughout the learning cycle.

## **Our School Budget**

- Our school received \$1 794 424 in 2024-25 to provide a quality education to our students and meet the goals in our school development plan (SDP).
- At least 75 per cent of budgeted funds covers staffing and the remaining portion covers instructional and operational supplies.




